**COMMITTEES WITHIN JSHOA**

By Laws Article VI

Committees are important to help with specific needs of the Association and will be composed of owners in good standing. Committees of the Association are appointed by the Board. Committees may be short term or be designated as a standing committee.

The work of the committee will be defined by a charge approved by the Board. Members of committees will be provided with information on how often and when the committee meets before they join a committee. If a member finds that they cannot fulfill their committee appointment, they are asked to notify the Association Manager so that another resident can replace them. Three absences in a six month period from regularly scheduled meetings will be deemed as a voluntary resignation from the committee.

Committee members will serve a two year term at which point they can indicate an interest to continue their committee work. There are no term limits on how long a committee volunteer may serve. The Board shall review and approve the list of committee members, including continuations for additional terms of existing committee members.
